

Mixed Media and Watercolor

Dive into the different materials and water-based media, including watercolor, ink, colored tissue paper and watercolor paper, and see how to get the most out of them. Learn to experiment with color by mixing different shades on paper, then discover playful and intuitive approach to generating ideas. Russ guides you through some exercises to get your own creativity flowing as you begin sketching the initial drawings for your art. Cut out the favorite parts of your drawings and experiment with composition through the use of collage.

Soft 2B, or 4B Pencils

Charcoal Stick - (Not Pencil)

Kneaded Eraser and or Magic Rub, Vanish or Art Studio Eraser (white)

White and black Gouache

Watercolor paint assorted colors or kit

Watercolor Palette

Two open container to hold water, (paper cups, jars etc)

Dip Pen and Ink

Liquitex Acrylic Medium (used as a glue)

Watercolor Pad; 9x12 (300 Series) or equivalent

Scissors

Colored Tissue Paper (mixed colors)
