

## **Kiwanis Lake Public Boating Information and Regulations**

## **Permit Fees and Availability for Purchase**

- Permits can be purchased online. Visit www.tempe.gov/boating for the link to purchase online permits.
  - Please call Parks and Recreation at 480-350-5200 for additional information if you are looking to purchase a permit in-person.
- Annual Boat Permit Fee \$5 per boat per year for Tempe Residents; \$10 per boat per year for non-Tempe residents

## **Requirements and Regulations**

Due to the size of the Kiwanis Lake and because it is an urban area, the regulations listed below have been established for public safety:

- City of Tempe Annual Boating Permit is REQUIRED, affixed to the stern of the boat.
- Boating permitted only between sunrise and sunset.
- Boats not to exceed 14 feet in length. Exceptions:
  - o Inflatable boats must be at least 6 feet in length and not exceed 14 feet.
  - o Canoes must have proper flotation and not exceed 17 feet in length.
- No SUPs, rafts, inner tubes, inflatable mattresses, catamarans or sailboards allowed.
- No motors (electric or gas) may be used in Kiwanis Lake.
- One serviceable Type I, II or III Coast Guard approved personal flotation device (life preserver) must be aboard boat for every person on board.
- Children 12 years of age or younger must wear a serviceable U.S. Coast Guard Type I, II, or III personal flotation device at all times while the boat is underway.
- NO overloading boat capacity.
- NO swimming or wading permitted in Kiwanis Lake.
- NO parking on launch area or driveways. Only launch boats at boat ramp at north end of Kiwanis Lake.
- All City of Tempe Ordinances and Arizona State Boating Laws apply. (Arizona Revised Statutes, Arizona Game & Fish Commission Regulations and City of Tempe Code).
- ALL BOATERS MUST ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEIR PERSONAL SAFETY.
