SUBJECT: March 12, 2024 Primary/Special Election Update



At the September 7, 2023, Regular Council Meeting (RCM), the City Council adopted a resolution (Resolution No. R2023.127) calling a Primary Election to be held on March 12, 2024, and a Regular (General) Election, if necessary, to be held on May 21, 2024, for the purpose of nominating and/or electing the Mayor and three members of the City Council. Also at the September 7th RCM, the City Council adopted a resolution (Resolution No. R2023.128) calling a Special Election to be held on March 12, 2024, for the purpose of submitting the General Plan 2050 to the Tempe voters for ratification. The Special Election will be held March 12, 2024, in conjunction with the City's Primary Election for the Mayor and three City Council seats.

Below are updates regarding the March 12, 2024 Primary/Special Election, for the week ending November 17, 2023.

City Council Candidate Filings

Monday, November 13, 2023 was the filing deadline for candidates for the Mayor and three City Council seats. One (1) Mayor and five (5) Councilmember candidates filed sufficient signature petitions and nomination paperwork to be certified for the March 12, 2024, election ballot. The deadline to file a nomination challenge in Maricopa County Superior Court is Wednesday, November 29, 2023.

On November 15, 2023, the City issued a <u>news release</u> regarding the candidates certified for the March 2024 City of Tempe Council Election, including information on the voter registration deadline and the mailing of ballots. Tempe residents who wish to vote in the March 12, 2024, election must be registered to vote by Monday, February 12, 2024. People can visit <u>BeBallotReady.Vote</u> or call the Maricopa County Election Department at (602) 506-1511 to check their voter registration status. As a ballot-by-mail election, all qualified voters who live in Tempe are automatically mailed a ballot beginning February 14, 2024. Completed ballots may be returned by mail, at Maricopa County drop boxes, or in person at vote centers. Information about vote centers and ballot drop boxes will be posted to <u>Locations.Maricopa.Vote</u> once available. Details about the March 12, 2024 Primary/Special Election are posted on <u>tempe.gov/election</u>.

General Plan 2050 "For" or "Against" Argument Filing Process

Tempe This Week: Nov. 13, 2023 included information regarding how people can file arguments in favor of or in opposition of the General Plan 2050. Arguments will be included in the publicity pamphlet, which is mailed to each Tempe household containing a registered voter beginning February 6, 2024. Arguments shall be filed electronically by email to clerk@tempe.gov and shall not exceed 300 words. An argument submission form is available in Word format. A \$100.00 deposit is required for each argument filed, to offset a portion of the proportionate cost of paper and printing the argument. Payment may be made by credit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover, or American Express is accepted), check or cash in person in the City Clerk's Office, 31 East Fifth Street, Tempe, AZ, 85281.

Each argument must include the sworn statement of its sponsor. If the argument is sponsored by an organization, the sworn statement of two executive officers is required. If the argument is sponsored by a political action committee, the sworn statement of the committee's chairperson or treasurer is required.

The deadline to file an argument is 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 13, 2023. To date, no arguments have been filed.
