**SUBJECT:** Police Video Record Fee Cost Analysis



In 2023, the Arizona State Legislature adopted Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") § 39-129 which allows cities to charge a one-time fee for the review and redaction of police video recordings. The Tempe Police Department intends to increase the fee that it charges for the review, redaction, and production of police video recordings in accordance with A.R.S. § 39-129. The statute sets a maximum amount of \$46 per video hour reviewed.

ARS 9-499.15 requires a written report that supports a new license or fee. Refer to the table below for the detailed calculation of the cost to review and redact police video recordings.
