The City of Tempe offers a free transit pass, valid on all Valley Metro bus routes and the light rail, to people ages 6 to 18 who live in Tempe and Guadalupe.

Passes will be valid June 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025, and can be picked up at the Tempe Transit Store located at 200 E. Fifth Street (parking is available at 117 E. Fifth Street), weekdays from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. A parent or guardian **MUST** be present, and proof of residency and a birth certificate is required.
