Tempe is home to more than 50 neighborhood and community parks. Here are some ways we can help everyone have a safe, enjoyable experience in our parks:

- Get a permit if you plan to use amplified sound or drink alcoholic beverages.
- Keep dogs on 6' leashes if you and your pup aren't in a dog park.
- If you want to use a ramada for more than four hours a day, please get a reservation.
- Keep access to trails, sidewalks and park amenities clear so that everyone can use them.
- Don't use park water for bathing, washing clothes, cleaning fish or other unsanitary activities.
