# Project Overview

---

This project will reconfigure the intersection at College Avenue and McKellips Road by removing the existing traffic signal and installing a new single-lane roundabout.



# Project Purpose

---

- Existing traffic signal no longer meets signal warrants
- Traffic calming
- Discourage heavy truck traffic through the neighborhood



# Project Goals and Objectives

---

- Promote safety
- Provide traffic calming without impacting vehicular connectivity
- Maintain existing bicycle and pedestrian connections
- Provide new landscaping and low impact development (LID) improvements
- Provide new street lighting



# Project History

---

- Project initiated in 2018
- Original project design completed in 2019
- Project put on hold due to funding availability
- Design re-started in 2024

# New Transit Shelters

- Two new “Micro” transit shelters
  - Orbit Earth route
    - Northbound College Ave. north of McKellips Road
    - Eastbound McKellips Road east of College Ave.
- New transit shelter design
- Overhead and vertical shade panels
- Seating for 2 – 4 people depending on location
- Solar lighting
