
Project Overview and Progress

Project Scope Tempe

- Sidewalk and ADA improvements
- Expanded pedestrian space
- New sidewalk pavers
- Historic markers
- Infrastructure upgrades to electric and irrigation
- New bus shelters
- New trees



Project Area Tempe









Phase 1: Intersection of Mill Avenue and University Drive.

- Upgrades to traffic signal infrastructure, sidewalk ramps.
 - Paver pattern on north side will be the same pattern installed on intersections at Seventh, Sixth, etc.
- Replaced pavers in roadway with asphalt.








Phase 2: University Drive to Seventh Street

- ADA improvements
- Streetlight pole foundation upgrades
- Sidewalk brick replacement with new brick between "bump outs".
 - Currently working "curb side" section of the sidewalk.





Phase 3: Seventh Street to Sixth Street

- Sidewalk brick removal, grading, and ADA improvements between "bump outs".
- Utility infrastructure upgrades.
- Hardscape/landscape upgrades.





Concrete bands will separate sidewalk and patios.


Schedule

Schedule Tempe

- Construction began April 2024.
- Phase 1: Work completed at the intersection of Mill Avenue and University Drive on Aug. 7, 2024.
- Phase 2: Work between University Drive and Seventh Street began Aug. 26, 2024, expected completion February 2025.
- Phase 3: Work between Seventh Street and Sixth Street began in Mid-October,
 2024.
- Total improvements from University Drive to Rio Salado Parkway along Mill Avenue completion date approximately Fall 2026.



- Current work hours are 7 a.m. 3 p.m., Monday-Friday
 - Primarily for work on the "curb-side" of the sidewalk.
- Work within the roadway is being completed at night from 7
 p.m. 5 a.m. For storm drain improvements and traffic signal improvements.
- Upcoming work on the "building side" of the sidewalks will likely be during nighttime hours, hours TBD.





- Coordinate deliveries to arrive before noon on Friday or they will be turned away.







Deliveries during festival:


- Delivery entrance ONLY at Fifth Street and Ash Avenue (the west end of Fifth Street). No deliveries will be allowed to enter from the East on Fifth Street, and none on the North or South on Mill Avenue.
- Permitted delivery hours: Approximately 11 p.m. 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, Dec. 5; and 9 p.m. 8:30 a.m. on Friday, Dec. 6, Saturday, Dec. 7, and Sunday, Dec. 8.
- All trucks must vacate the event area BEFORE 9 a.m. each day of the Festival.
- Should your deliveries not arrive before 9 a.m., please contact Ally at 616-260-4657 and we will determine the alternate load-in options available so that delivery can be accommodated, if possible.






