Clark Park Community Garden: a collaborative effort of the Clark Park and Marilyn Ann Neighborhood Associations, and Tempe Community Action Agency. The garden was created in 2014 at the site of a former municipal pool. The Garden has built 21 beds, of which 18 currently are

rented.
