


## Svob Park Improvements 1<sup>st</sup> Meeting Survey Results Feb. 8- Feb. 29, 2016


- 1. I like to have a little more separation between the two playgrounds

#### **Layout C:**


1. It's the fastest growing sport in America. I love playing golf in the morning, having lunch, then playing pickleball in the afternoon. I call that my "weekday triathalon";)










4. The open lawn area currently has older field lighting for use at night. Do you want the city to replace the sports field lighting on the east side of the park?





5. Would you like the city to add portable soccer goals to the open lawn area on the east side of the park?








### Safety of the park

- 2. I'm very happy that you guys are doing this renovation to svob park.
- 3. Shade is wonderful! Leave as many trees planted as possible! Repair/replace water fountain if possible, current water fountain doesn't work so well. Mosquitos in drainage/retention basin after big rains is a bit problematic.
- 4. Very opposed to ground maze, drum circle, par-fit, mazes, horsehoe. Would like to see mosquito fogging automatically following big rain. The retention basin takes a long time to dry and is a huge breeding ground for mosquitos. I understand it's a County function, but having an open line of communication between City and County. There have been several instances that it's been needed.
- 5. There are group sports played regularly at night- ultimate frisbee, soccer, etc., so lights are important. I've never seen anyone play any sports that require the backstop, except people using it as a soccer goal. I feel like more benches will be needed than what is shown in the proposed layouts, especially near the east fields. Parents routinely watch their children playing and practicing sports there. The dog run would be much appreciated.

- 7. Please spray retention basin for mosquitos after there has been a big rain.
- 8. Fog park after big rains retention breeds mosquitos
- 9. If the backstop is removed from the park, please contact me as I would like to have it. Thank you.
