
Svob Park Improvements 2nd Meeting Survey Results April 11 – April 25, 2016

2. Why did you choose this option?


Option A:

3. Is there anything else you'd like to see in either option?


- 1. Benches or even a couple picnic tables so we could take food and watch kids longer!

4. Where would you like the shade structure placed?




