

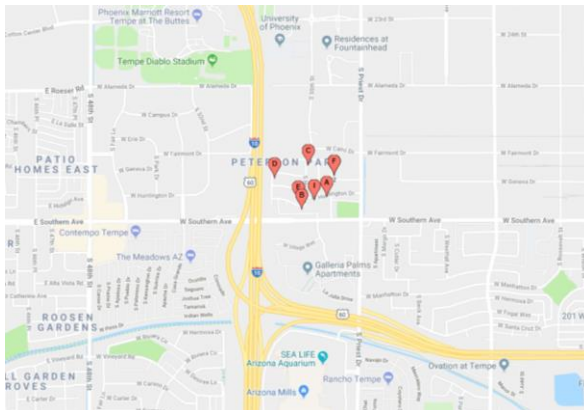


**PUBLIC INPUT SUMMARY**

**Overview**

A public meeting was held on May 5, 2018 to get feedback on planned improvements for Petersen Park. Residents in the area of Southern to Fairmont, Priest to the 101 (183 residents) were invited to participate in the process via postcard. Notices were also posted to Nextdoor to 48 households in 1 neighborhoods (Petersen Park) directing residents to both the meeting and the website. Four (4) people signed in for the meeting. Residents were asked to provide input on playground design and overall plans for the park. Surveys were available at the meeting and online from May 5 through May 19, 2018. A total of 9 survey responses were received; 4 at the meeting and 5 online, 1 from outside the project area.

**Map of Survey Respondents**

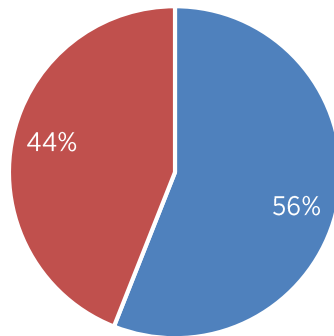
