
Agenda Item: 2

<u>ACTION</u>: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Hall Property located at 1248 W. 10th Place. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: \$1190.00 for abatement request, landscape cleanup and removal of junk, trash, debris and other discarded household items.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180 day open abatement

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the HALL PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE194523: landscape cleanup and removal of junk, trash, debris and other discarded household items.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Hall Property located at 1248 W. 10th Place, in the R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 06/27/2019, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve a 180 day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

1248 W 10TH PL is currently in violation of City of Tempe's Nuisance Code 21-3-b-1 trash, litter, debris, buckets, bicycle tires, palm fronds & tree branches debris in the back yard; 21-3-b-8 over height grass and weeds in the front, west side and back yard landscape.

The property has been in violation since 06/26/2019 with the initial violation being trash, litter, debris, buckets, bicycle tires, palm fronds, tree branches debris in the back yard; over height grass and weeds in the front, west side and back yard landscape. There has been minimum effort from the owner to correct the violations.

The owner Charles Hall has been issued several correction notices and a citation in an attempt to correct the violations. As stated above, minimum effort from the owner has been done, which means the property violations remains unresolved as of this date. Notice of intent to abate was mailed to the owner & posted to the property.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Charles Hall has made minimum attempt to remedy the violations upon the property at 1248 W 10TH PL. Since this property remains in violation, without the intervention of abatement, the property will continue to deteriorate. I therefore make a request to the City of Tempe Development Services Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code and authorization of multiple abatements for a period not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) days from the previous abatement order. Charles Hall has given no indication that he plans on correcting the violations and maintaining the property.

This serves as notification of the City of Tempe's intentions regarding the abatement of code violations on the following described property:

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda of December 17, 2019. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

Please remove all trash, litter, debris, buckets, bicycle tires, palm fronds & tree branches debris in the back yard.

CC 21-3.b.8

Please cut all over height grass and weeds in the front, west and back yard landscape areas.

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$1190.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen (15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the City for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.


