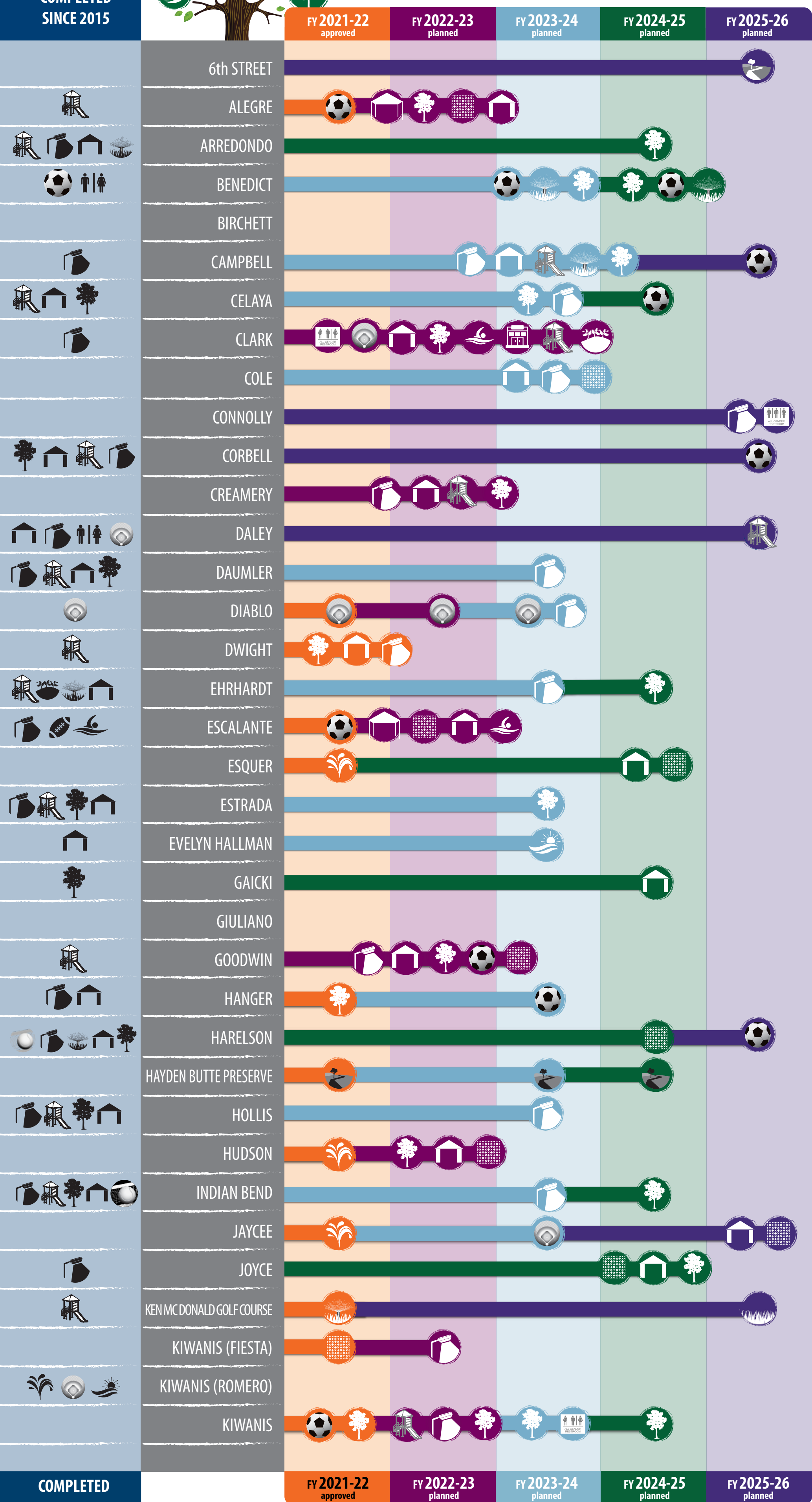

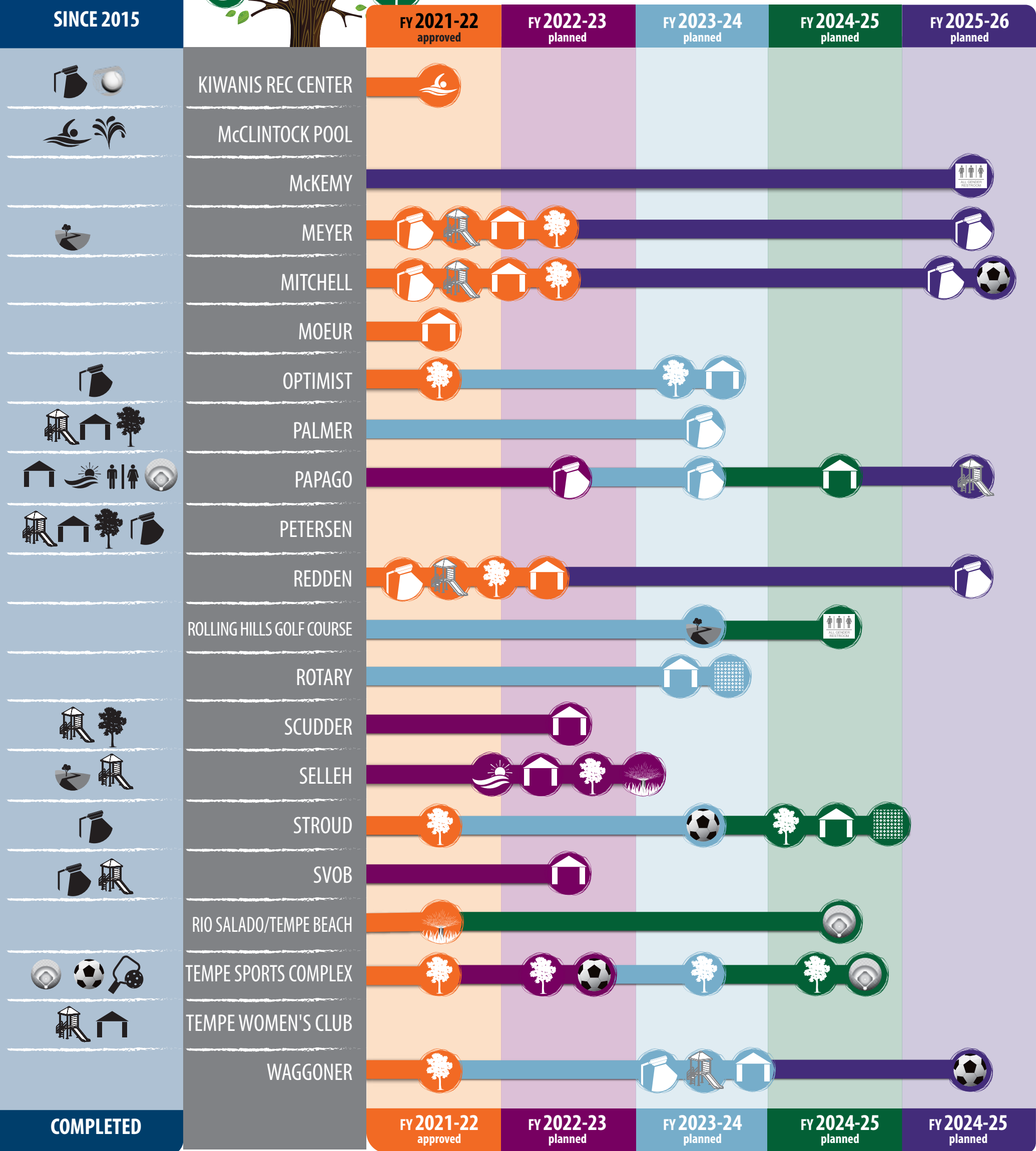

ASSET MANAGEMENT

Funding for capital projects is prioritized based on:

- 1: Public Health & Safety
- 2: Existing Assets (i.e., take care of what we have)
- 3: Customer Enhancements
- 4: System Expansion and New Amenities

A condition rating of the assets in each park is used to allocate capital improvement dollars for park projects primarily in numbers 1 and 2. The different park assets are listed in the legend.

Since 2015, significant investment in the parks capital improvement program is addressing the backlog of needed improvements. Public input is encouraged as the City continues its parks improvement projects.

2021-22:

These projects are currently approved and budgeted in the Capital Improvement Program (CIP).

2022-23 through 2025-26:

These projects represent planned projects based on current condition rating, priorities, and the planned but not yet approved 5-year CIP. These may change based on final approved budgets each year.
