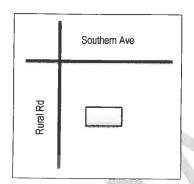
Agenda Item: 5

**ACTION:** Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Veatch Property located at 3620 S Terrace Road. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** \$901.00 for abatement request, including over height grass/weeds and deteriorated landscaping throughout the front and back yards, Security on site.

**RECOMMENDATION**: Staff – Approval

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the VEATCH PROPERTY (CE200718). The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE200414: deteriorated landscape. The request includes the following:

## **COMMENTS:**

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Veatch Property located at 3620 S Terrace Road. in the R1-6, Single Family Residential District. This case was initiated 02/04/2020 following which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve the abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

There has been no change in the landscape. The citation has not been paid, so therefore 04/12/2020

it went to collections. Requesting a bid for the cleanup of the landscape in the front and

sides of the property. The hearing is set to be scheduled for May 19th, 2020

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

I am recommending the approval for the abatement at 3620 S. Terrace Rd. The property is owned by Maxwell Veatch. The owner has been given ample time and opportunities to bring this property into compliance and has failed to take any corrective action. Several notices were mailed, and a citation was issued. I am also requesting that an open abatement of 180 days be granted to cover any future violations.

This serves as notification of the City of Tempe's intentions regarding the abatement of code violations on the following described property:

Location: 3620 S TERRACE RD TEMPE, AZ 85282

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda of May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020, located at the Tempe Council Chambers, 31 E 5th Street, at 5pm. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

CC 21-3.b.8

Landscaping that is substantially dead, damaged or characterized by uncontrolled growth or presents a deteriorated or slum-like appearance.

If the violations have not been corrected within thirty (30) days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below:

CC 21-3.b.8

- a. Remove all grass and or weeds from the front and sides of the property in gravel landscape.
- b. Cut any grass and or weeds in the back yard of the property.

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$901.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen(15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the City for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.

## Violation of City of Tempe Code 21-3-B-8

Any landscaping, visible from public property, that is substantially dead, damaged, or characterized by uncontrolled growth, or presents a deteriorated or slum-like appearance; uncultivated plants, weeds, tall grass, uncultivated shrubs or growth (whether growing or otherwise) higher than twelve (12) inches; or any dead trees, bushes, shrubs or portions thereof, including stumps; or any palm or similar type tree having dead or dry fronds descending downward from the base of the lowest living frond more than eight (8) feet or dry fronds longer than five (5) feet and closer than eight (8) feet to the ground.

## PLEASE TAKE THE FOLLOWING CORRECTIVE ACTION:

1. PLEASE REMOVE ALL GRASS AND OR WEEDS FROM THE FRONT AND OR SIDES OF THE PROPERTY IN THE GRAVEL LANDSCAPED AREAS. ALL GRAVEL LANDSCAPES MUST BE MAINTAINED FREE AND CLEAR OF ANY UNCONTROLLED GROWTH REGARDLESS OF HEIGHT.
