
Agenda Item: 8

ACTION: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Vo Property located at 910 W. Redfield Drive. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$545.00 for abatement request: Front and side yard landscape cleanup.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180 day open abatement

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the VO PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE201645: Front and side yard landscape cleanup.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Vo Property located at 910 W. Redfield Drive, in the R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 03/11/20, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve a 180 day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

03/09/20 – The Code Compliance Division received a complaint on the above property concerning deteriorated landscape.

03/11/20 - The property was inspected and found to have weeds/grass growing within the gravel landscape in the front and side yard. First correction notice was mailed to Mr. Vo.

03/11/20 – The property was inspected with no change to its condition. A pink notice was posted to the door to remove the weeds by 3/18/20 or a citation would be issued.

03/30/20 - The property was inspected with no change to its condition. Final notice was mailed to Mr. Vo.

04/22/20 - Received the bid from Hamann Enterprises to clean the landscape for \$545.00.

05/07/20 – The property was inspected with no change to its condition. Code Compliance filed for an Abatement with a hearing date of 6/2/20.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

I recommend the approval for abatement at 910 W. Redfield Rd., which is owned by Mr. Thang Vo. Mr. Vo has been given ample time and opportunities to bring his property into compliance and has failed to take any corrective action. Since Mr. Vo is unable to maintain his property, I am requesting approval for continuous abatements in the next 180 days if deemed necessary. There has been no indication from Mr. Vo that he plans to correct and maintain his property.

This serves as notification of the City of Tempe's intentions regarding the abatement of code violations on the following described property:

This office will submit this complaint to the Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda of June 2, 2020. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of: Those items constituting a violation of TCC-21-3-b-8 which would include the following: landscape clean-up in the front and side yard.

As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct the violation. If the violations have not been corrected within thirty days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$545.00 In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen (15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the city for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate for judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.
