
Agenda Item: 6

ACTION: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Ruiz Property located at 1325 E. Don Carlos Avenue. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$3268.00 for abatement request: remove dead tree in back yard.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180 day open abatement

<u>BACKGROUND INFORMATION</u>: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the RUIZ PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE204836: remove dead tree in back yard.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Ruiz Property located at 1325 E. Don Carlos Avenue, in the R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 07/28/20, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve a 180 day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ABATE PUBLIC NUISANCE

This serves as notification of the City of Tempe's intentions regarding the abatement of code violations on the following described property:

LEGAL: Book 132, Map 62, Parcel 086, as recorded with the Maricopa County Assessor.

LOCATION: 1325 E DON CARLOS AVE

This office will submit this complaint to the Development Services Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda of 11.17.2020. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

VIOLATIONS: CC 21-3.b.8 - Dead trees or parts including stumps

As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct the violation. If the violations have not been corrected within thirty days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$3268.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen (15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the city for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate for judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.

07/28/2020: The violation of a dead tree was brought to our attention by an anonymous party. Upon in section could verify the violation and subsequently sent out a first notice.

08/18/2020: No corrective action was taken, or communication initiated. A final notice was sent.

08/31/2020: No corrective action was taken, or communication initiated. A citation was issued.

09/16/2020: Anonymous concerns continue to come in about the existing violation.

09/23/2020: The citation entered default.

10/07/2020: Anonymous concerns continue to come in about the existing violation.

10/09/2020: Abetment paperwork initiated based on lack of corrective action.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The owner of this property Ruiz Armando F / Polly has made no attempt to bring the property into compliance. Ruiz Armando F / Polly has had several abatements conducted on his property over the past several years and shows no inclination to maintain the property. Due to the continual lack of maintenance a 180-day open abatement is being sought for this property. I therefore request the City of Tempe Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

Please take the precautionary measure to properly trim and regularly maintain deteriorated dead limbs from the tree's structural make-up. As an option the tree itself could be excavated to permanently eradicate the concerns. If not familiar with the regulations regarding dead trees or parts of, please familiarize yourself with the City of Tempe Chapter 21 Nuisances Codes for clarification of the violation under article 21-3.b.8. All debris must be discarded appropriately in approved city dump sites or bins. Lastly, make sure that your property is being maintained on a regular basis, if not regularly present please make proper arrangements to address such issues.

This issue must be addressed. If your property is out of compliance again in a twelve-month period for the same violation/s, reoccurring violation fees and citations can be issued without warning or further notice. Please contact me at your earliest convenience.

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COMPLAINT
