
Agenda Item: 2

ACTION: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Gibleski Property located at 3231 S. Birchett Drive. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$3332.00 for abatement request: remove dead limbs from pine trees in back yard.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180 day open abatement

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the GIBLESKI PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE200963: remove dead limbs from pine trees in back yard.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Gibleski Property located at 3231 S. Birchett Drive, in the R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 02/20/20, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve a 180 day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

In February of 2020, my office received a complaint for the property. An inspection was conducted, with violation(s) of City Code observed, and a notice was mailed to the property owner(s)

In April of 2020, I followed up at the property and observed little to no change with regards to the violation. A second notice was mailed to the property owner

In May of 2020, I followed up at the property and observed little to no change with regards to the violation. I returned to the property and posted a notice to the front of the structure

In July of 2020, I followed up at the property and observed little to no change with regards to the violation

In August of 2020, I issued a citation to the property owner and posted it to the front of the structure

In October of 2020, I followed up at the property and observed little to no change with regards to the violation. I sought bids to abate the property, as well as received a subpoena for Court. The Court case was dismissed as another party took responsibility for property maintenance via the City Court, but did not communicate with my office to discuss the reasons why

In November of 2020, I followed up at the property and observed little to no change with regards to the violation. An abatement application was submitted for addition to the 01/05/2021 hearing agenda

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The owner(s) of this property, MAUREEN GIBLESKI, have/has made little to no attempt to bring the property into compliance. MAUREEN GIBLESKI have/has not had a prior abatement conducted on this property. Due to the failure of the property owner(s) to address this matter, a 180-day open abatement period is being sought for this property. I therefore request the City of Tempe Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

This serves as notification of the City of Tempe's intentions regarding the abatement of code violations on the following described property:

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda to be held on 01/05/2021 at 5pm, at the City of Tempe Council Chambers, located at 31 E. 5th Street, Tempe. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

CC 21-3.b.8 Dead pine tree limbs

If the violations have not been corrected within thirty (30) days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below:

CC 21-3.b.8 Please remove the dead, pine tree limbs, located on the trees in the backyard landscape

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$3,332.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen(15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the City for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.
