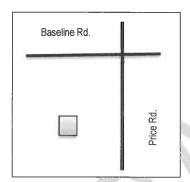
Agenda Item: 5

ACTION: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Trujillo Property located at 6737 S. Kenneth Place. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$597.00 for abatement request: cut over-height grass, remove unregistered vehicle.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180-day open abatement

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the TRUJILLO PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE210407: cut over-height grass, remove unregistered vehicle.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Trujillo Property located at 6737 S. Kenneth Place, R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 01/21/21, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve 180-day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

01/21/2021 The Code Compliance Division received a complaint for an unregistered vehicle parked in the driveway. Inspected the property, and there is an unregistered Cadillac with AZ license plate of SRH1 parked in the driveway. A notice was mailed to the owner, Robert Trujillo.

02/04/2021 Went to the property to inspect. There has been no change in the condition of the vehicle, it is not registered. A final notice was mailed.

02/26/2021 Called and left a message for Anita Trujillo, who is on the water bill.

03/09/2021 Did not hear back from Anita. Inspected the property, the violation of unregistered vehicle still exists. Issued a citation. Pictures were taken as well to show the condition of the property. The citation was mailed through regular mail and also certified. The grass and weeds are now over height and growing in a mainly dirt landscape. A notice for the landscape was mailed.

03/10/2021 Received a phone call from Anita. She thought it was a different vehicle in question. Went over the code for unregistered vehicles and talked about her landscape as well.

04/01/2021 Mailing a final notice for the landscape and requesting bids to have the unregistered vehicle towed and the grass cut.

04/09/2021 Turning in the paperwork for the abatement hearing to be held on May 18th. 2021.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

I recommend an abatement of the nuisance violations at the property at 6737 S. Kenneth Pl. due to property owner's failure to bring property into compliance with Tempe City Code 21-3. B.8 and 21-3. B.3. Robert Trujillo has been given ample time to come into compliance and maintain the property. There has been no indication that the property owner will bring the property into compliance. The property represents an eyesore to the community.

Without the intervention of abatement, the property will continue to deteriorate. I therefore make a request to the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code and authorization of multiple abatements for a period not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) days from the previous abatement order.

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda of May 18th, 2021 located at the Tempe Council Chambers, 31 E 5th Street, at 5pm. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

CC 21-3.b.3 An unregistered vehicle outside of or under a roof area not enclosed

CC 21-3.b.8 Uncultivated weeds in gravel landscape, or a lawn higher than 12 inches

If the violations have not been corrected within thirty (30) days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below:

CC 21-3.b.3 Please register or remove vehicle

CC 21-3.b.8 Please cut over height weeds and or grass in the front yard of the property.

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$597.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen (15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the City for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.
