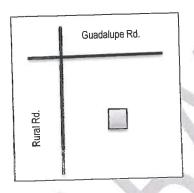
Agenda Item: 6

ACTION: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Nelson Property located at 6736 S. Kenneth Place. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$1880.00 for abatement request: remove unregistered vehicle, landscape cleanup including tree stump removal, remove junk, trash and debris from property.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180-day open abatement

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the NELSON PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE210408: remove unregistered vehicle, landscape cleanup including tree stump removal, remove junk, trash and debris from property.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Nelson Property located at 6736 S. Kenneth Place, in the R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 1/21/21, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve 180-day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

01/21/2021 The Code Compliance Division received a complaint for an unregistered vehicle parked in the driveway. Inspected the property, and there is an unregistered Kia Van with AZ license plate of 850VZA parked in the driveway. A notice was mailed to the owner, Susan Nelson.

02/04/2021 Went to the property to inspect. There has been no change in the condition of the vehicle, it is not registered. A final notice was mailed.

02/10/2021 Received a call from Susan Nelson. She said her husband had passed away in September and was still trying to take care of things. She requested an extension which was granted until March 5th.

03/05/2021 Received another call from Ms. Nelson requesting more time. Was granted until March 24th.

04/02/2021 Spoke to Ms. Nelson again and granted one more week.

04/20/2021 Inspected the property, the violation of unregistered vehicle still exists. Issued a citation. Pictures were taken as well to show the condition of the property.

05/21/2021 The landscape is now displaying grass and weeds in the gravel, vegetation debris, and over height grass. There are some items visible from the front. A notice was mailed to cover the landscape and junk, trash, debris. The citation was paid. However, the vehicle is still in violation. Requesting a bid to cover all items. Hearing will be July 6th, 2021.

05/28/2021 Turning in the paperwork for the abatement hearing.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

I recommend an abatement of the nuisance violations at the property at 6736 S. Kenneth Pl. due to property owner's failure to bring property into compliance with Tempe City Code 21-3. B.8, 21-3. b.1, and 21-3. B.3. Susan Nelson has been given ample time to come into compliance and maintain the property. There has been no indication that the property owner will bring the property into compliance. The property represents an eyesore to the community.

Without the intervention of abatement, the property will continue to deteriorate. I therefore make a request to the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code and authorization of multiple abatements for a period not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) days from the previous abatement order.

This serves as notification of the City of Tempe's intentions regarding the abatement of code violations on the following described property:

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda of July 6th, 2021 located at the Tempe Council Chambers, 31 E 5th Street, at 5pm. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

CC 21-3.b.3	An unregistered vehicle outside of or under a roof area not enclosed
CC 21-3.b.1	Filthy, littered, debris or trash-covered exterior areas, including exterior areas under any roof not enclosed by the walls, doors or windows of any building
CC 21-3.b.8	Landscaping that is substantially dead, damaged or characterized by uncontrolled growth, or presents a deteriorated or slum-like appearance; or any dead trees, bushes, shrubs or portions thereof, including stumps

If the violations have not been corrected within thirty (30) days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below:

CC 21-3.b.3	Please register or remove unregistered vehicle from the front of the property.
CC 21-3.b.1	Please remove trash, litter and debris from property. Even items seen under the garage door.
CC 21-3.b.8	Remove dead tree stump, remove grass and weeds from gravel areas, cut down all over height grass and or weeds from non-gravel areas.

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$1880.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen (15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the City for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.

Violation of City of Tempe Code 21-3-B-3

Any inoperable or unregistered vehicle, or parts thereof, outside of or under a roof area not enclosed by walls, doors or windows of any building on any lot, except the safe and neat keeping of:

- a. Substantially complete inoperable or unregistered vehicles with inflated tires under the roof area of any building;
- b. A vehicle undergoing repair, titled to the owner or resident of the property, provided that the repair is complete within fourteen (14) days after the repair was begun, provided that not more than three (3) such fourteen (14) day repairs will be permitted in any twelve (12) month period;
- c. Not more than two (2) ongoing restoration projects or inoperable or unregistered vehicles in a backyard area, screened by a substantially opaque fence at a minimum height of five (5) feet or the height of the vehicles, whichever is more, provided that any fence constructed or modified pursuant to this subsection must meet any and all other requirements of the city code;
- d. Lawful commercial activities involving vehicles as allowed by the Zoning and Development Code; or
- e. Operable, off-road vehicles, under the roof area of any building, or in a backyard area, screened by a substantially opaque fence at a minimum height of five (5) feet or the height of the vehicles, whichever is more, provided that any fence constructed or modified pursuant to this subsection must meet any and all other requirements of the city code.

Violation of City of Tempe Code 21-3-B-8

Any landscaping, visible from public property, that is substantially dead, damaged, or characterized by uncontrolled growth, or presents a deteriorated or slum-like appearance; uncultivated plants, weeds, tall grass, uncultivated shrubs or growth (whether growing or otherwise) higher than twelve (12) inches; or any dead trees, bushes, shrubs or portions thereof, including stumps; or any palm or similar type tree having dead or dry fronds descending downward from the base of the lowest living frond more than eight (8) feet or dry fronds longer than five (5) feet and closer than eight (8) feet to the ground.

PLEASE TAKE THE FOLLOWING CORRECTIVE ACTION:

1. VEHICLES OUT IN THE OPEN MUST BE REGISTERED AND APPEAR OPERABLE. PLEASE PROPERLY REGISTER ANY UNREGISTERED VEHICLE(S) WITH AZ MVD AND DISPLAY CURRENT PLATES AND OR TAGS. OR REMOVE THE VEHICLE(S) FROM THE FRONT OF THE PROPERTY. CAR COVERS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.

2. PLEASE CUT ALL OVER HEIGHT GRASS AND OR WEEDS IN ANY-NON-GRAVEL LANDSCAPED

AREAS.

3. PLEASE REMOVE ALL GRASS AND OR WEEDS FROM THE FRONT AND OR SIDES OF THE PROPERTY IN THE GRAVEL LANDSCAPED AREAS. ALL GRAVEL LANDSCAPES MUST BE MAINTAINED FREE AND CLEAR OF ANY UNCONTROLLED GROWTH REGARDLESS OF HEIGHT.

4. PLEASE REMOVE AND OR PROPERLY DISCARD THE ITEMS IN THE FRONT AND OR SIDE OF THE PROPERTY. THIS INCLUDES THE TRASH, HOUSEHOLD ITEMS, VEGETATION DEBRIS, AND ANY OTHER MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS.

5. PLEASE EITHER CLOSE THE GARAGE ALL THE WAY SO THAT ITEMS ARE NOT VISIBLE FROM THE FRONT, OR REMOVE ANY ITEMS SEEN UNDER THE GARAGE DOOR.

6. CUT DOWN TO GROUND LEVEL OR REMOVE THE DEAD PALM TREE STUMP.
