
Agenda Item: 5

ACTION: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Singh Property located at 820 W. Tulane Drive. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$1788 for abatement request: landscape cleanup, remove sidewalk/street obstructions, remove trash, litter and debris from property.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180-day open abatement

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the SINGH PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE212864: landscape cleanup, remove sidewalk/street obstructions, remove trash, litter and debris from property.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Singh Property located at 820 W. Tulane Drive, R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 05/05/21, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve 180-day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

05/05/2021 The Code Compliance Division received a complaint for this property for deteriorated landscape, junk, trash, and debris, deteriorated roof, deteriorated paint, and fence. Inspected the property, and there was grass and weeds growing throughout the gravel landscape, junk, trash, and debris in the front and back of the property, a deteriorated fence that has missing slats and semi falling down. There are also sidewalk obstructions from the trees as well. There was not enough deterioration to address the roof or the paint on the property. A notice was mailed to the property owner, Siri Singh.

06/08/2021 Re-inspected the property. There has been no change to the property. A pink hanger was hung on the door to see if contact can be made. A final notice was mailed.

06/10/2021 Contact was made with the stepdaughter of the property. She said that the property owner died, and the property will be going into foreclosure. She said that there was no beneficiary of the property. She said she would try to get someone over to the property to fix some of the items, but if nothing was done by July 6th, then I should move on with the case and do whatever I needed to do to correct the violations.

06/16/2021 An anonymous complaint came in for deteriorated landscape, roof and paint, at this property.

06/17/2021 An anonymous complaint came in for deteriorated landscape, roof and paint, at this property.

07/07/2021 There has been no change to the property. Requested a bid to cover the junk, trash, and debris, deteriorated landscape, and sidewalk obstructions.

07/14/2021 Turning in the paperwork for the abatement hearing to be heard on August 17th, 2021.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

I recommend an abatement of the nuisance violations at the property located at 800 W. Tulane Dr. due to property owner's failure to bring property into compliance with Tempe City Code 21-3. B.8, 21-3. B.1, and 21-3-B.7. Mr. Singh has apparently passed away and there is no one to care for the property properly. There has been no indication that the property owner (or family) will bring the property into compliance. The property represents an eyesore to the community.

Without the intervention of abatement, the property will continue to deteriorate. I therefore make a request to the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code and authorization of multiple abatements for a period not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) days from the previous abatement order. This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda of 8/17/2021 located at the Tempe Council Chambers, 31 E 5th Street, at 5pm. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

CC 21-3.b.1	Filthy, littered, debris or trash-covered exterior areas, including exterior areas under any roof not enclosed by the walls, doors or windows of any building
CC 21-3.b.7	Object, building, tree, bush or vehicle that interferes with or obstructs a sidewalk or street
CC 21-3.b.8	Landscaping that is substantially dead, damaged or characterized by uncontrolled growth, or presents a deteriorated or slum-like appearance; or any dead trees, bushes, shrubs or portions thereof, including stumps

If the violations have not been corrected within thirty (30) days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below:

CC 21-3.b.1	Please remove trash, litter and debris from property
CC 21-3.b.7	Please trim vegetation so it does not obstruct passage of sidewalk or street
CC 21-3.b.8	Remove grass and weeds from gravel landscape. Cut any over height grass and or weeds.

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$1788.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen (15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the City for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.
