

# Materials for Oil and Acrylic Painting

**Paint colors** most brands work just fine for oil painting. Liquitex is preferred for Acrylic.

- Titanium White large tube (Windsor Newton preferred for oil painters)
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Cadmium Red Light
- Ultramarine Blue
- Burnt Umber
- Alizarin Red (Optional)
- Cerulean Blue (Optional)
- Ivory Black (Optional)
- Yellow Ocher (Optional)

## Medium

- Liquid (small bottle) optional
- **Odorless** mineral spirits (Gamsol is good)
- 2 containers, screw top large jar or metal can designed for mineral spirits and a second screw top jar for cleanup
- Small spray bottle for Acrylic painters

**Brushes** – please invest in good brushes

- Bristle or synthetic, long handle
- Long flats #2, #6, #8 #12
- Round #4
- Rigger #4
- Palette knife, medium size, pointed

**Palette** minimum 9x12, larger is better

- Covered palette fitted with disposable paper sheets or plexiglass

## Surfaces

- Canvas panel or stretched canvas minimum 9x12
- Canvas pad (9x12 inexpensive)

## Clean up

- Odorless mineral spirits or Gamsol
- Water for Acrylic

## Misc.

- Strong paper towels
- A flat box to carry the wet canvas
- Apron or paint shirt
- Gloves optional
