
Agenda Item: 5

**ACTION:** Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Thirkhill Property located at 2519 E. Huntington Drive. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** \$1059.04 for abatement request: remove stored items, box containers, junk, trash and debris from property.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff – Approval of 180-day open abatement

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the THIRKHILL PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE206879: remove stored items, box containers, junk, trash and debris from property.

### **COMMENTS:**

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Thirkhill Property located at 2519 E. Huntington Drive, R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 10/30/20, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve 180-day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

#### **FINDINGS:**

On 10/30/20, my office received a complaint for the property.

On 11/03/20, I visited the property and confirmed a violation of City Code, related to junk/debris, was present. I mailed a violation notice to the property owner, requesting the violation be remedied.

On 11/10/20, I received a voicemail from Mr. Thirkhill, stating he had interior home damage, items outside for interior repairs, that he expected work to be completed within next 30 days' time.

On 12/28/20, I visited the property and confirmed a violation of City Code, related to junk/debris, was present. I mailed a second violation notice to the property owner, requesting the violation be remedied.

On 01/28/21, I visited the property and confirmed a violation of City Code, related to junk/debris, was present.

On 01/29/21, I visited the property and posted a notice to the front of the structure.

On 02/03/21, I received a voicemail from Mr. Thirkhill, requesting an extension until an unspecified date. I called him back, reaching him, where he repeated that interior household issues resulted in materials being stored outside the house. I granted him an extension.

On 03/04/21, I visited the property and observed notable progress on the removal of stored items, but the work remained incomplete at the time.

On 03/05/21, I called Mr. Thirkhill, reaching him. He said that due to progress inside the house, he could begin moving items into the home. I told him I wanted to see the work completed by 04/05/21.

On 03/08/21, my office received another complaint related to the state of the property.

On 04/23/21, I visited the property and observed little to no change at the property.

On 05/10/21, I visited the property and issued a citation to Mr. Thirkhill, placing it in the mail via U.S. Certified Mail. Mr. Thirkhill requested a court hearing.

On 06/14/21, I appeared for court, telephonically, but Mr. Thirkhill failed to appear. The Judge found Mr. Thirkhill in default, sending the fine to collections.

On 06/16/21, I visited the property and observed a junk/debris violation present on the property. I then sought bids for property abatement.

On 07/23/21, I submitted the abatement packet for addition to the 09/01/21 hearing agenda.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

The owner(s) of this property, **GREG THIRKHILL**, have/has made little to no attempt to bring the property into compliance. **GREG THIRKHILL** have/has not had a prior abatement conducted on this property. Due to the failure of the property owner(s) to address this matter, a 180-day open abatement period is being sought for this property. I therefore request the City of Tempe Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda to be held on 09/01/2021 at 5pm, at the City of Tempe Council Chambers, located at 31 E. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Tempe. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

CC 21-3.b.1 Junk/debris

If the violations have not been corrected within thirty (30) days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below:

Please remove the stored items, junk and debris from the east side of the house storage. Please remove the box container from the east side of the house storage.

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$1,059.04. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen(15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the City for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.




