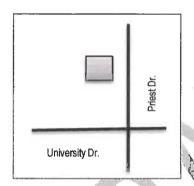
Agenda Item: 3

<u>ACTION</u>: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Schultz Property located at 1418 W. 6th Street. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$3210 for abatement request: remove miscellaneous items stored on the property.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180-day open abatement

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the SCHULTZ PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE213846: remove miscellaneous items stored on the property.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Schultz Property located at 1418 W. 6th Street, in the R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 06/21/2021, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve a 180-day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

06/21/2021 The Code Compliance Division received a complaint for this property regarding deteriorated landscape and junk, trash, and debris.

06/24/2021 An inspection, that was conducted by Code Inspector Brandy Zedlar, found that the property was in violation for missing landscape in the front yard and junk and debris in the carport. A notice was mailed to the owner, Charles Shultz Jr.

07/22/2021 Code Compliance received another complaint for this property regarding a deteriorated landscape, junk, trash, and debris, and deteriorated paint. Code Inspector Brandy inspected the property and found to be no change in the condition of the property. A final notice was mailed to the owner.

08/05/2021 Code Inspector Julie Scofield took over this case. Went to the property to inspect. The violations found included, appliances, auto parts, metal, bike parts, furniture, and miscellaneous items stored in the front and back yard. There was a broken window in the front of the property. The landscape consisted of dirt, with some grass and weeds growing in it. A notice was mailed to the owner. Charles Shultz Jr.

09/15/2021 Reinspected the property. There had been no change to any of the violations. A final notice was mailed to the property owner.

10/18/2021 Received an email from Lynn Shultz requesting more time to correct the violations. An extension was granted.

11/04/2021 Another complaint was received regarding the junk and debris and landscape.

11/30/2021 The window in the front of the property has been replaced. The landscape has shown improvement and a grass landscape is growing. The items in the front and

back of the property are still in violation. I emailed the owner giving two more weeks for the items stored in the front and back yard.

12/16/2021 The items in the front and back yard are still in violation. A citation, #1702433 has been issued to the owner. Pictures were taken to show the condition of the property.

01/13/2022 The citation was paid on 12/30/2021, but the violation has yet to be corrected. Requested a bid to conduct an abatement.

01/24/2022 Turning in the abatement packet for the hearing to be heard on March 1st, 2022, for the violation of storing items in the front and back of the property.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

I recommend an abatement of the nuisance violation at the property located at 1418 W. 6TH St., due to property owner's failure to bring property into compliance with Tempe City Code 21-3. b.1. Mr. Shultz was issued multiple notices. A citation was issued and has been paid, but the violation still exists. There has been no indication that the property owner will bring the property into compliance. The property represents an eyesore to the community.

Without the intervention of abatement, the property will continue to deteriorate. I therefore make a request to the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code. I also request that the abatement be approved for 180 days.

We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

Filthy, littered, debris or trash-covered exterior areas, including exterior areas under any roof not enclosed by the walls, doors or windows of any building

As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below. If the violation(s) have not been corrected, our office will proceed with the abatement process.

CC 21-3.b.1

Please remove items from being stored in the front and back yard of the property.

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$3210.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen percent (15%) of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the city for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.
