



## PUBLIC INPUT SUMMARY – MAY 2022

### I. Background

The City of Tempe works to offer opportunities for play, shaded spaces, and comfort in our neighborhood parks. Towards that effort, new playground equipment, a new ramada, accessible walkways, landscape buffer, new lighting and trees are scheduled for Campbell Park. Residents were asked to provide input on theme, playground equipment, a new ramada and overall park experience.

### II. Outreach

Several methods were used to provide information to the public regarding the project, meeting and opportunities for input.

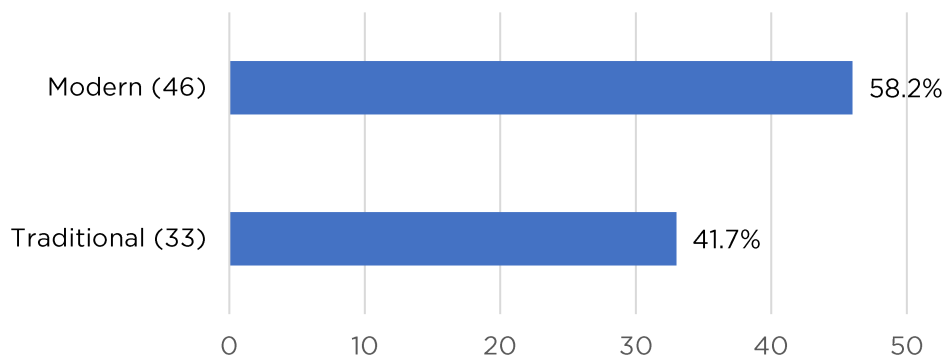
- Two direct mail postcards were sent to 1,343 households in the project area from Kyrene Road to I-10 between Warner Road to Ray Road. The first postcard included meeting and survey information and the second a reminder to provide comments.
- Notification email to neighborhood contacts and Kyrene de las Manitas Elementary School inviting them to attend the meeting, comment online and share with neighbors.
- Yard signs were posted in the park.
- Notification email to relevant Boards and Commissions inviting them to attend the meeting or to comment online.
- Nextdoor post to the project area with meeting and comment information with 132 impressions.
- An open house was held on April 30 at Campbell Park with approximately 20 attendees and an on-demand online session was available 24/7 and has been viewed 40 times.
- The topic was posted on the project website for input from April 20 through May 8, 2022. Surveys were collected at the in-person meeting and online with a total of 83 received.
- A survey was provided to Kyrene de las Manitas Elementary School students with 153 received.

Map of respondents:

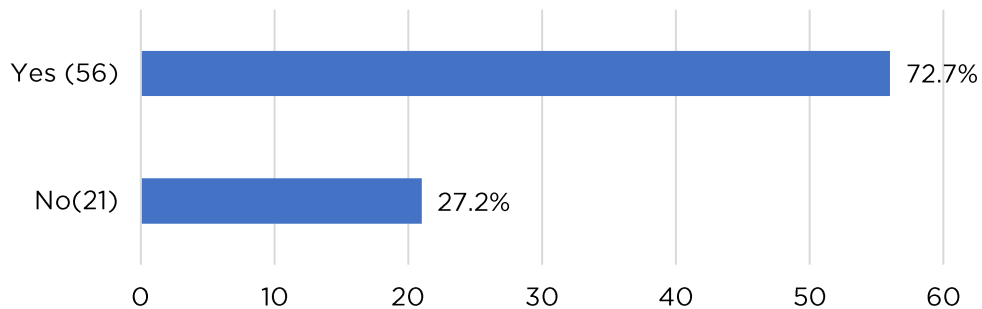


1. The playground design for Campbell Park will include a play structure for 5-12 year-olds. Should this play structure be *traditional*, or *modern* (see examples)?



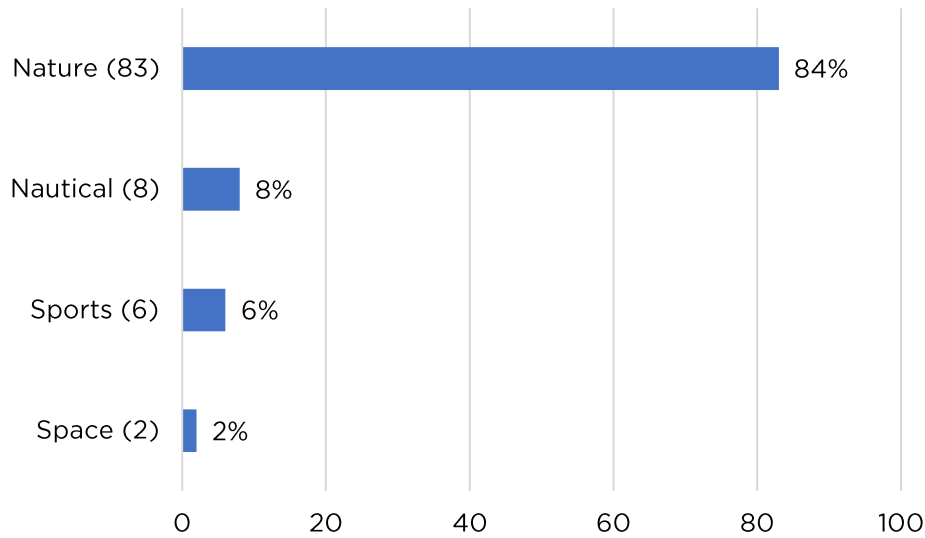

3. If yes, what theme? (Examples include: nature, specific sports, nautical)



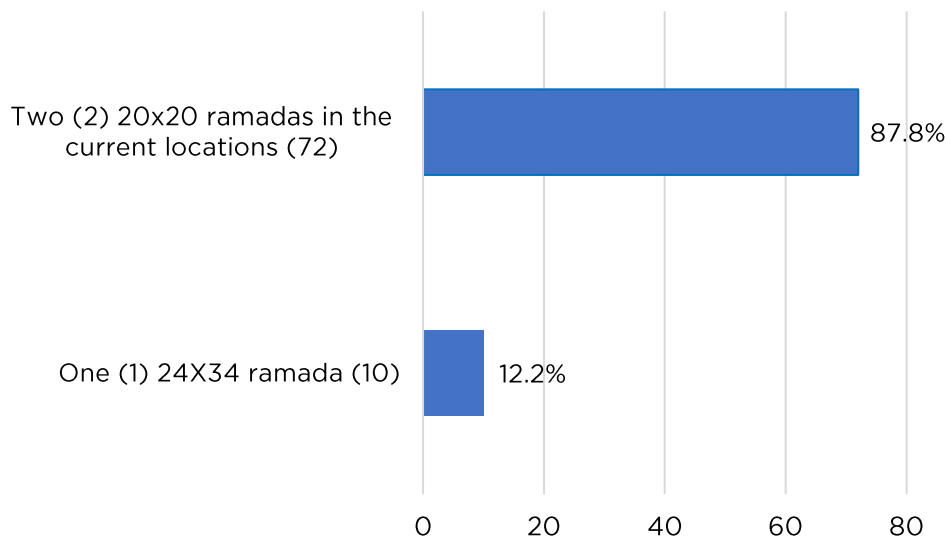

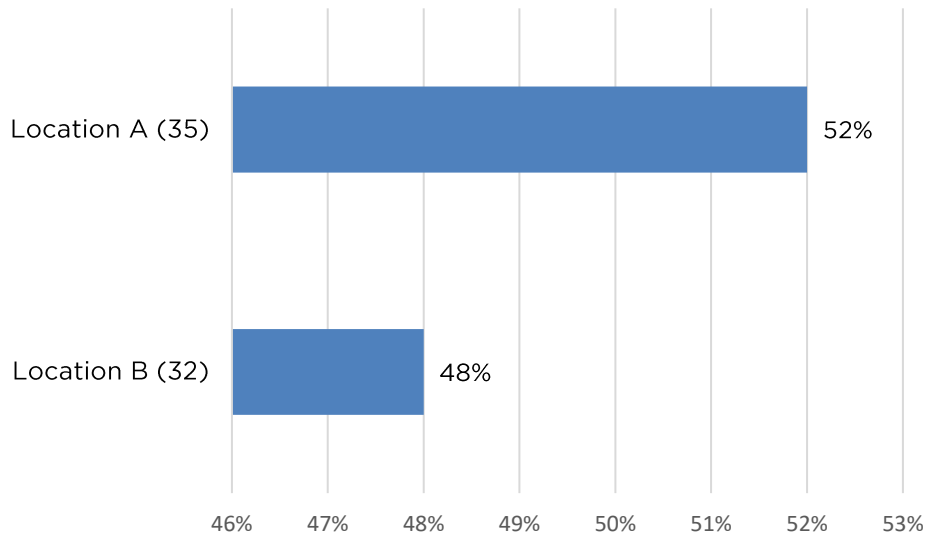

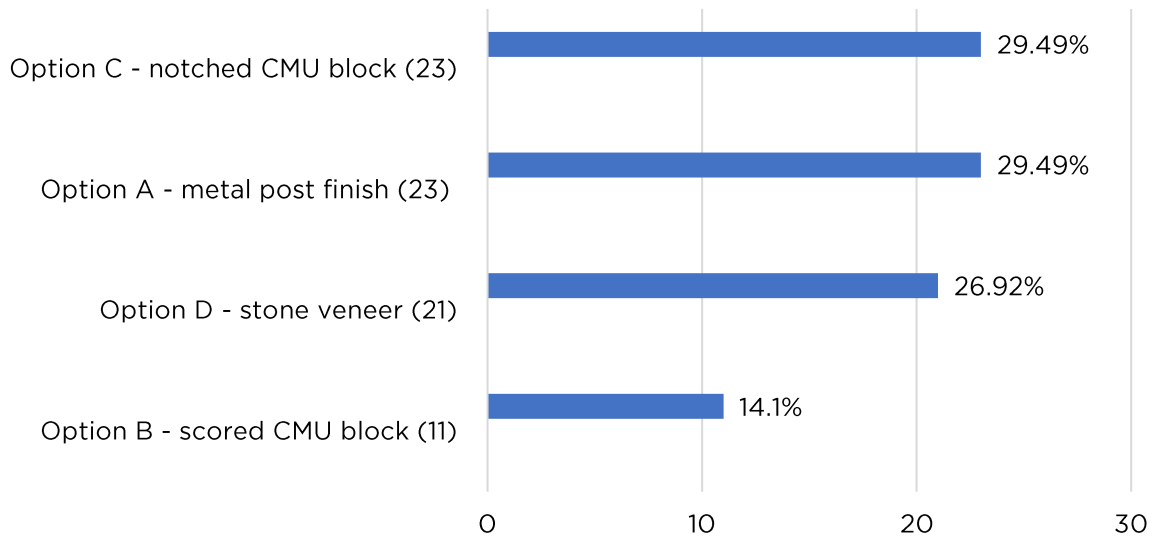

7. The picnic ramada will have a metal hip roof. Which column material do you prefer?

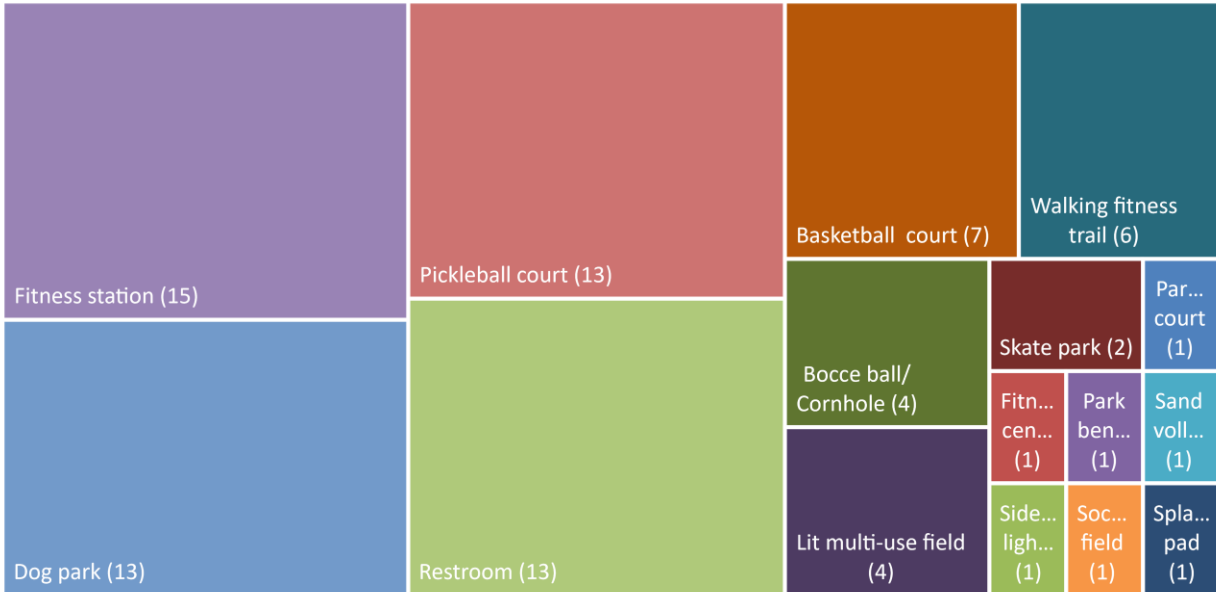

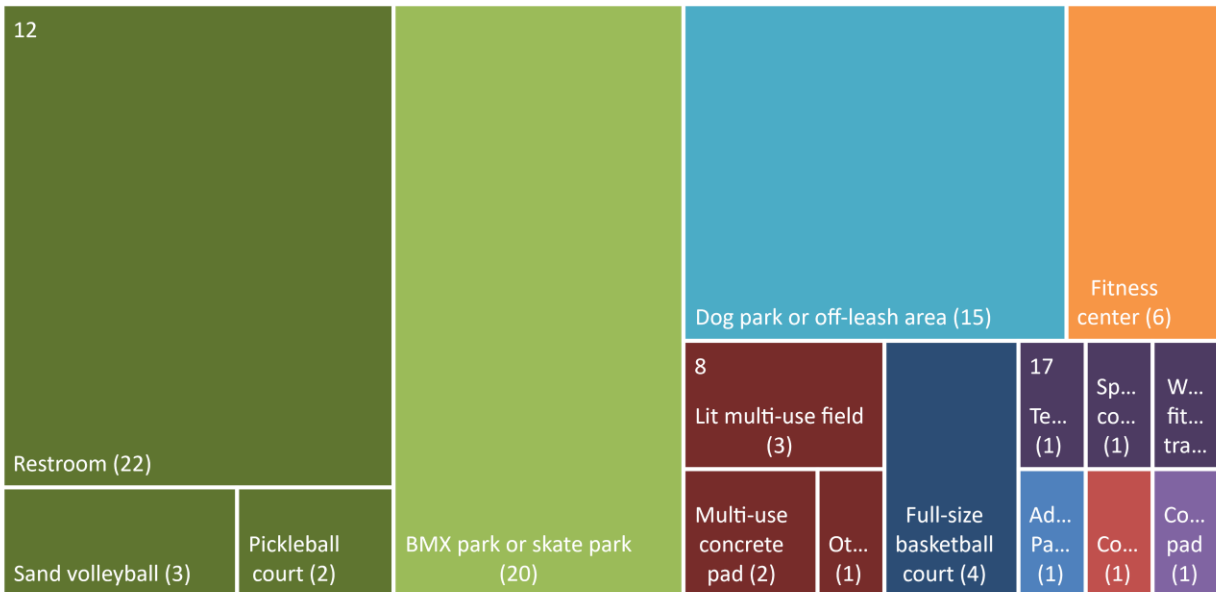
Please select the enhanced amenity you would most like to see in Campbell Park:

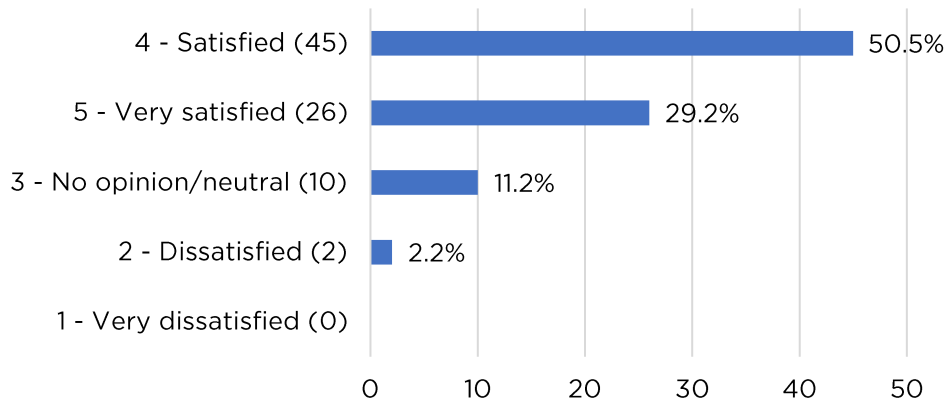
Please select the enhanced amenity you would **least** like to see in Campbell Park:

#### Cleanliness of Campbell Park

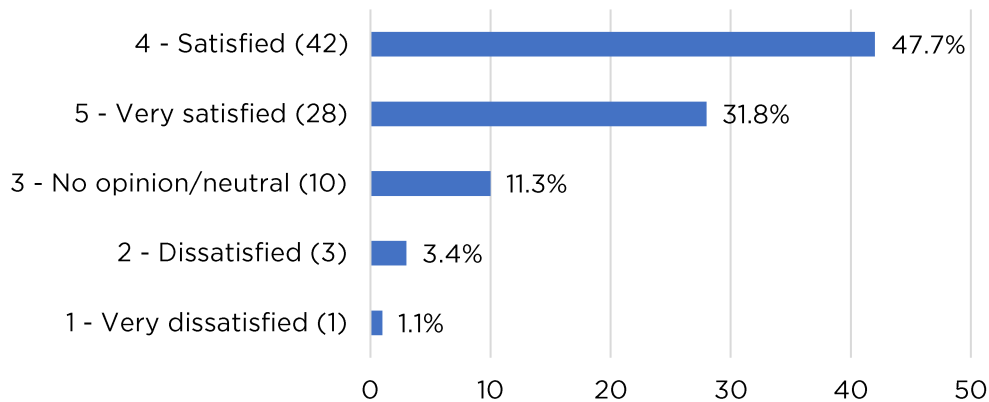

#### Safety of Campbell Park

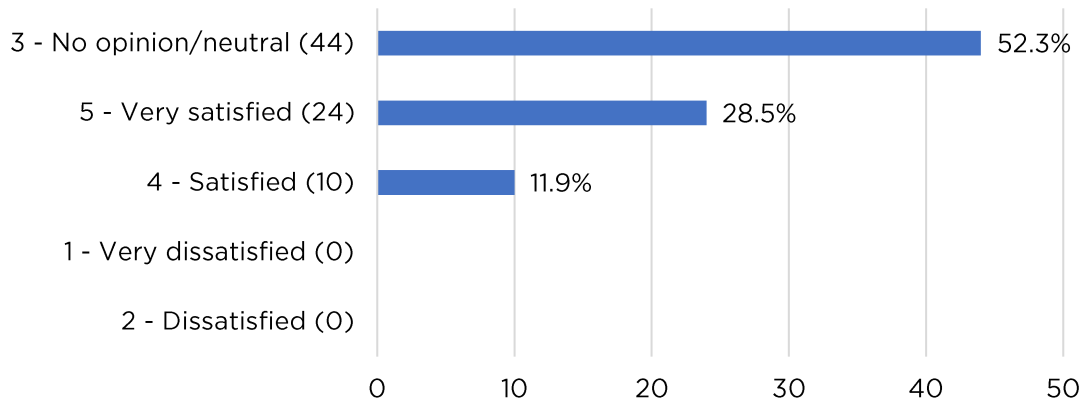

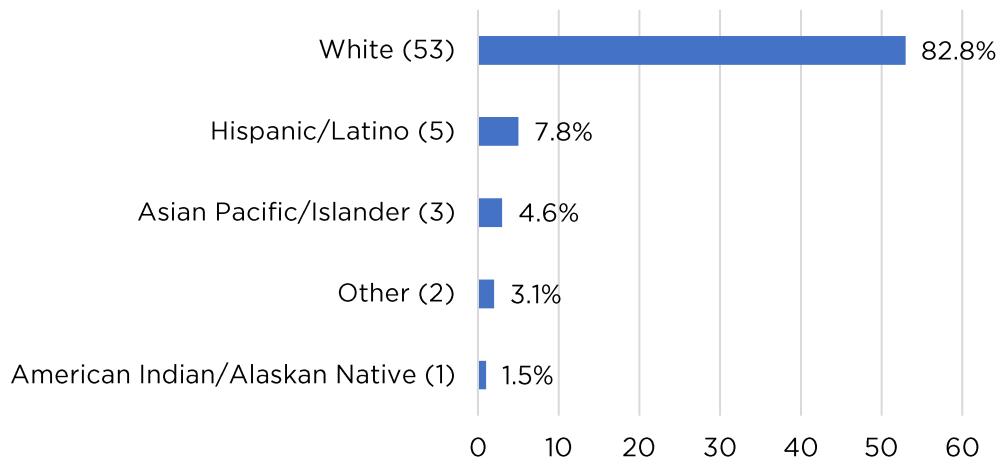
1. add more benches along the sidewalk on north edge preferably under shade trees. lots of dog walkers would use. place bench in grass with bench facing sidewalk

I have joint pain and inflammation in my knees, but I still need to be active. My doctor told me to run less and walk much more to build strength, so I come almost every day to take walks around and in the grassy fields, as the grass puts less pressure on my joints. Please no more basketball or tennis courts, as I like walking on the grass and it is good for strengthening my joints. Also, please add more lights so that walking in the evening is more safe. I think a fitness center is a great idea. Me and my husband could use these centers to work out our arm and legs while our family plays in the park. it would be a great addition to our workouts. My kids also uses the swings every time we are in the park. Please add more arch swings/swings for teens and children. Sometimes they can't use the swings because there is only 1 older child/teen/adult swing available and they get sad about it. Swings are fun for everyone. And please oil the swing so there is not rust/noise/squeaking. Thank you so much for reading



7. I did not respond to playground ideas since it is not something I use.
8. I feel that adding restrooms will attract people living/sleeping in the park (we have had this happen from time to time) and this makes the park feel less safe. Thanks for the donuts!
9. I have lived in this neighborhood for 20+ years, and go to the park almost every day, either alone or with family. I know the kind of people that come to the park. I have 4 major points: an added fitness center, more lights, no more courts, and SWINGS. My first and most important point is more swings for older kids/teens/adults. There used to be two swings, now there is only 1 arch swing. All the local teens come to the park and use the swings. I am an adult, but I enjoy using them as well. Sometimes there are lines for the swings! And it's a bit uncomfortable using the swings because you know you don't have long because 5 other kids/teens want to use it. Please please please add more arch swings! And please make them rust-proof or something, because there have been times the swings were so old and rusted that they squeaked non-stop, which ruins the mood of the park. Second, the people who come to this park are almost always either parents with new families (babies/toddlers), or grandparents taking their grandkids here. A fitness center for the elderly/older people (so that they may work out as their kids play) is a great idea. It would also be an added incentive for grandparents to come, so that they too can have fun and work out. Usually when the kids play, the parents/grandparents just sit around or go on their phones, so this would be an added benefit for our community. Third, more lights for the field would be great (makes it safer to take walks-the park gets a little scary after sundown/at sunset). Finally, I know from my experience that this is a park where a LOT of people take walks and enjoy for the quietness/scenery. We actually have quite a bit of cool wildlife here, including desert cottontails and vermilion flycatchers! More courts could potentially displace these animals. I would hate to see the beautiful field shortened so that more courts can be made. Also, a lot of middle schoolers and elementary kids play soccer here, so cutting the field would be a bad idea. On top of that, a lot of people bring their dogs to run around in the field, so again a big field is a must. And there are already many parks nearby with courts, so we don't need more here.
10. I have three priorities for the park: 1) More trees. All of the fallen ones have not been replaced over the years. 2) Park benches around the park. There is nowhere to sit and enjoy the outdoors other than the picnic tables. 3) Lower Kelvin temperature lighting! The park had nice subdued lighting until recently. We used to enjoy relaxing on the east side of the park at night, but not now. It is lit up more like a sports field or roadway, neither of which it is. Please bring back the lower temperature and not as bright lighting, that is more appropriate for a small neighborhood park.
11. I like that this is a smaller city park and I would like to keep it that way. I live in the neighborhood and I feel safe sending my kids (ages 9 and 11) to the park with their friends. I worry if Campbell Park starts attracting a lot more people, it won't feel as safe anymore. I think it's a great park the way it is and needs minimal improvements, but could definitely use more shade.

13. If they chose the aquatic/pirate theme's. Maybe some type of splash pad or water themed activity for the summer heat.

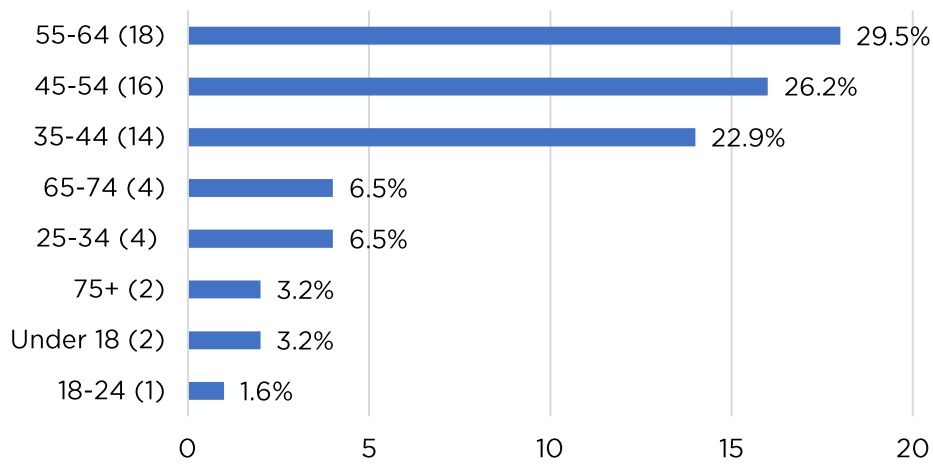
14. More shade structures over play equipment, especially where the swings currently are located. Not so tall, otherwise the sun still creeps in underneath the shade structure.

The dog park and bathrooms would require expensive maintenance and upkeep that we don't want to see the city spending money on. It would also require an increase of security enforcement which would strain already limited city resources.

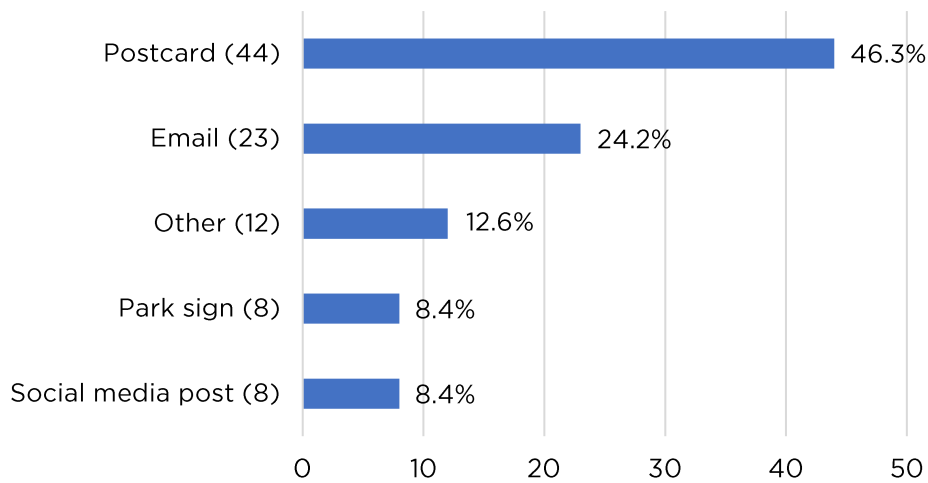

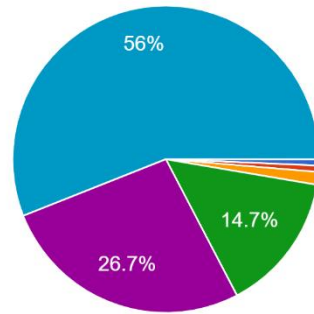

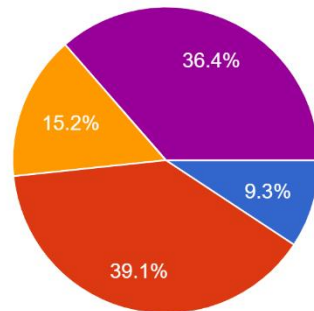

### The new playground will include arch swings. What other type of swing do you like most?

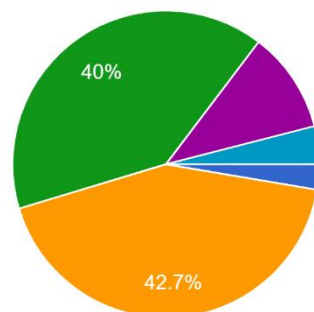

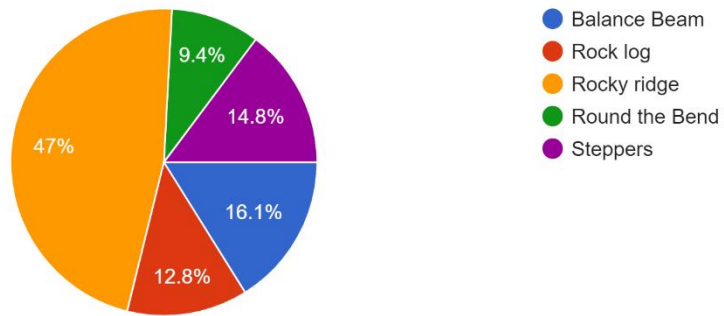

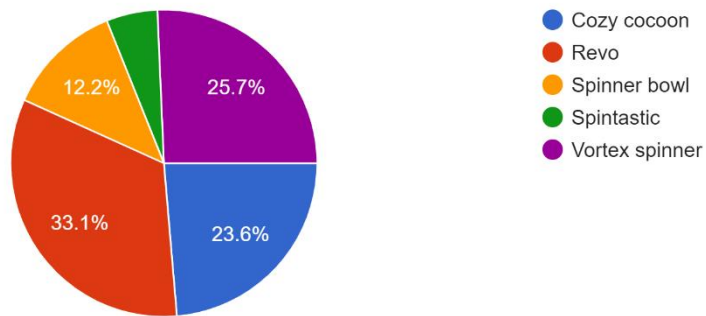
### What's your favorite type of balance equipment?

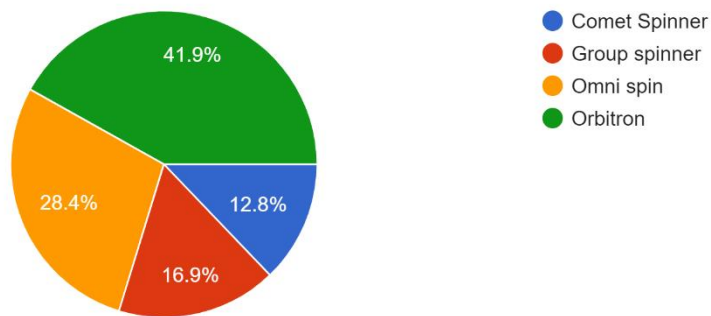
### What's your favorite type of single spinner?

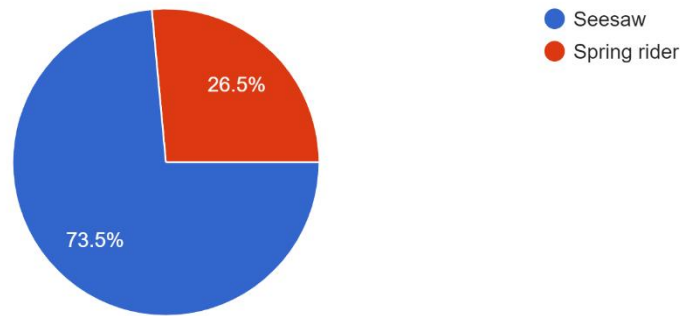
### What's your favorite type of group spinner?

148 responses



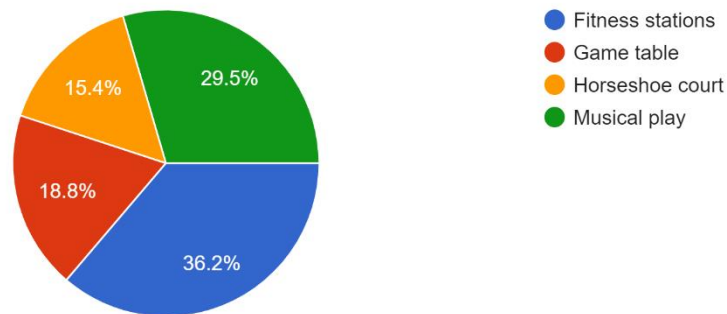
### What's your favorite type of spring play?
