
Agenda Item: 4

ACTION: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Angel Property located at 1240 E. El Parque Drive. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$910.00 for abatement request, remove dead fronds on palm tree in front yard.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180-day open abatement

<u>BACKGROUND INFORMATION</u>: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the ANGEL PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE217736: remove dead fronds on palm tree in front yard.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Moulton Property located at 1240 E. El Parque Drive in the R1-6, Single Family Residential District. This case was initiated 12/29/21 following which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve the 180-day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

12/29/21 - Case was opened proactively for a tree obstructing the sidewalk and excess dead palm fronds on trees in the front yard. Notice to comply was mailed to Alicia Angel on 12/29/21, with a re-inspection date of 01/24/22.

01/24/22 – The property was inspected and the sidewalk obstruction was cleared but the excess fronds remained. A 1st violation notice was sent for the excess fronds with a re-inspection date of 02/14/22.

02/15/22 – The property was inspected and the excess fronds were still present. Final notice was sent with a re-inspection date of 03/07/22.

03/16/22 – No change was observed to the property. A door notice was left at the property asking the owner to contact me regarding the excess fronds.

04/27/22 – Palm tree in the front yard still not trimmed. Measured dead fronds at over 8 feet in length and closer than 3-4 feet from the ground. No contact had been made by the owner. Citation #1702157 was issued.

07/19/22 – The property was inspected with no change to its condition. Code Compliance filed for an Abatement Hearing. Notice was posted to the property.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

I recommend the approval of a 180-day open abatement period for removal of excess fronds from 1240 E. El Parque Drive, which is owned by Alicia L. Angel. The owner has been given ample time and opportunities to bring this property into compliance and has failed to take any corrective action.

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer located at the Tempe City Council Chambers 09/06/2022. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

CC 21-3.b.8

Any palm or similar type tree having dead or dry fronds descending downward from the base of the lowest living frond more than eight (8) feet or dry fronds longer than five (5) feet and closer than eight (8) feet to the ground

As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below. If the violation(s) have not been corrected, our office will proceed with the abatement process.

Please trim/remove the dead, low hanging palm fronds, from palm tree(s) located on the property.

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$910.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen percent (15%) of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the city for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.




