

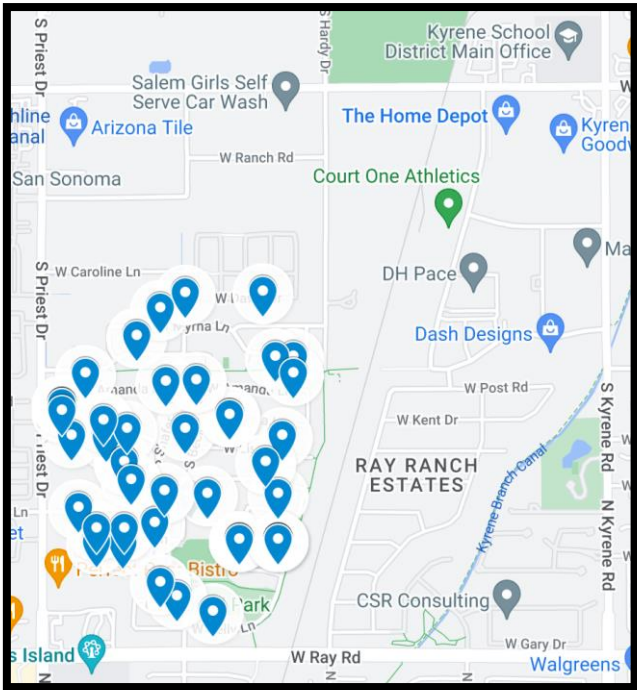
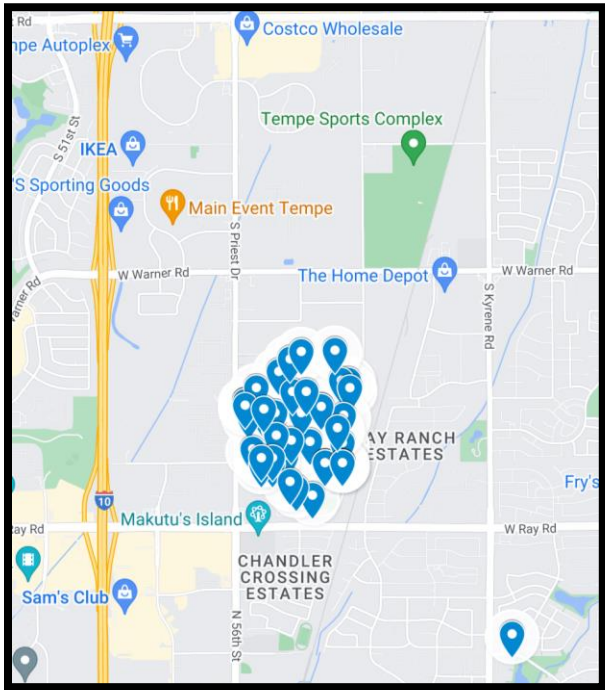


### Public Input Summary

#### Overview

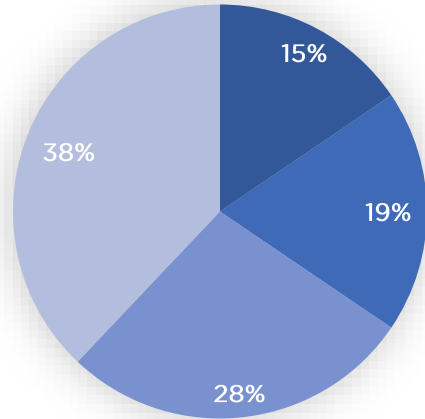
A public meeting was held on September 19, 2022, for feedback on planned improvements for Campbell Park. Residents in the area of Warner Rd. to Ray Rd., Priest Dr. to Kyrene Rd., on the west side of the train tracks (1343 households) were invited to participate in the process via postcard. Notices were posted to Nextdoor to 777 households directing residents to both the meeting and the website. Signs were also placed in the park announcing the meeting. Residents were asked to provide input on playground equipment layout, playground color palette, and shade structure locations. Surveys were available at the meetings and online from September 17 through October 2, 2022. A total of 59 survey responses were received: 7 at the meeting and 52 online, 7 from outside the project area.

#### Map of Survey Respondents



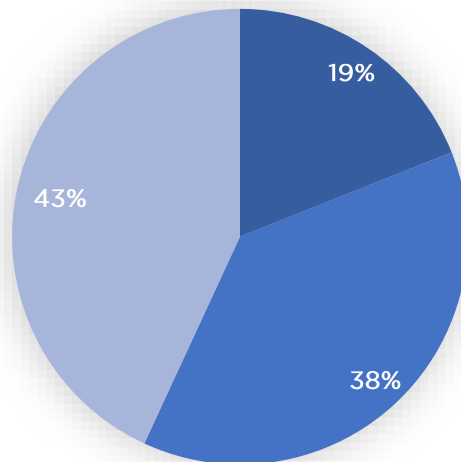
## Survey Results

1. Which play structure design and playground equipment layout incorporating these choices do you prefer?



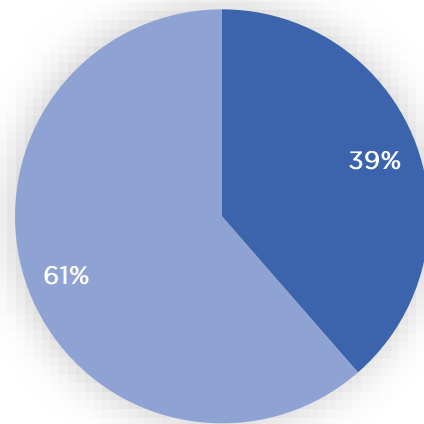
■ Playground "C" (9)      ■ Playground "B" (11)

15. More teen/adult swings please! We always need more swings for the older kids, teenagers, and young adults in the neighborhood. There is always a line because there is only two swings for the older people available. Right now, there's only one, because the second one was mysteriously taken away. Please give us more swings. And make sure the swings are facing towards the field (like how they are now) because that way, the sun is hitting them in the back. Thank you!
16. I do wish that the exercise area had more to it. I do like the scattered benches ideas and more trees but would love to see the grass improved. Bermuda Tiff is an overall strong grass but does not like a lot of shade. Adding more sunshades is also a needed feature. I would also love having the splash park and dog park. So please add more swings. The swings should also face the same way they are facing now, facing the soccer field, because this allows the sun to be at our backs while we swing.
